Goal

The University of Michigan Spectrum Center/Kellogg Scholarship will provide five \$2,000 scholarships to those who demonstrate strong engagement in and who have made significant contributions to lesbian, gay, bisexual and transgender students and ally activism.

Eligibility

To be eligible, applicants must meet all of the following criteria:

- be enrolled as a full-time undergraduate or graduate student for the 2009-2010 academic year at the Ann Arbor campus
- demonstrate financial need as determined by the Office of Financial Aid (OFA), based on information submitted to the Office of Financial Aid
- willingness, if asked, to write a letter of thanks to the Kellogg Foundation/Kellogg Company in recognition of their sponsorship

The Spectrum/Kellogg Scholarship is open to students regardless of sexual orientation, gender identity or gender expression.

Application Requirements

- Completed Application Form
- Supporting documents from the Office of Financial Aid demonstrating financial need.

Deadlines

- Submission deadline: August 1, 2009

Notification

- Notification will occur no later than August 15, 2009.

Renewability

- None. These scholarships are available only for the academic year of 2009-2010.
