### Goal

This scholarship has been established to provide funds to University of Michigan—Ann Arbor undergraduates with financial need, who have at least one parent who is a University of Michigan—Ann Arbor faculty or staff member with at least a 50% appointment. Funding for this program is from prior balances in the University's prepaid medical and dependent care reimbursement accounts.

### Eligibility

Any undergraduate student may apply if he/she is enrolled on the UM—Ann Arbor campus and a child of a UM—Ann Arbor faculty or staff member with at least a 50% appointment. To be considered for this scholarship, the student must demonstrate financial need as determined by the Office of Financial Aid (OFA), based on information submitted on the 2004–2005 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA).

### Application Requirements

Students interested in applying for this scholarship must submit:

1. **A scholarship application form (on the reverse side) to OFA.** Additional copies are available at the front desk of OFA: 2011 Student Activities Building. The application may also be viewed and printed from the Web at [http://www.finaid.umich.edu/types\\_of\\_financial\\_aid/scholarships/scholapp.asp](http://www.finaid.umich.edu/types_of_financial_aid/scholarships/scholapp.asp).
2. **A 2004–2005 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) to the federal processor.** In Step Six of the FAFSA, be sure to list the University of Michigan—Ann Arbor and the Federal School Code 002325. Copies of the FAFSA are available from OFA or you may complete it online at <http://www.fafsa.ed.gov>.

### Deadlines

Scholarship applications must be submitted to OFA by **March 26, 2004**; FAFSA forms must be submitted to the federal processor by **March 1, 2004**.

### Number/Amount

Each year, eight scholarships of up to \$1,000 each are awarded.

### Notification

Scholarship recipients will be notified by April 15, 2004.

### Renewability

Scholarships are for one year only, but students may reapply in following years.

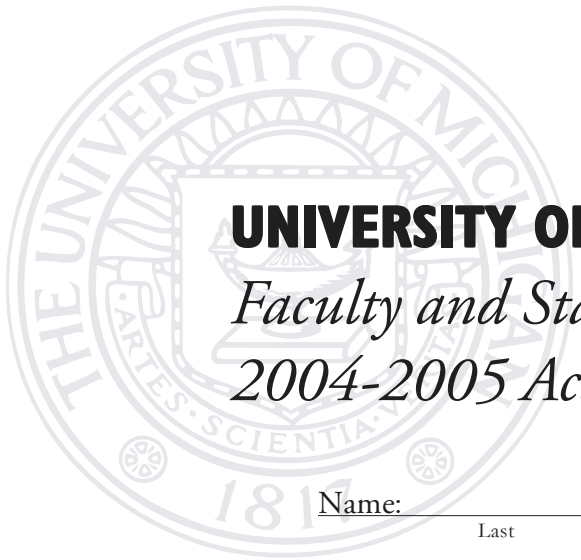
